**AIRPORT INSPECTION:**

The airport inspection was done by Lew Mason:

- A. One Taxi Reflector needs replaced.

- A. Darel Fuller will be rebuilding the lock on the Operations Building.
- B. Washington State Community Airport Association Annual meeting: Richard Pearce will be attending and the meeting place has been moved to Icicle Inn in Leavenworth, WA.
- C. Hangar Road has been graded and looks good.
- D. West side land status: Has been mowed and looks good.

**NEW BUSINESS**

- A. Runway Overlay Project – Trey Dail gave an update on times for overlay and how to enter & exit the runways. Construction dates are set for August 28 – 29<sup>th</sup> and September 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, and 4<sup>th</sup>. There was some concerns about closing the runways for the Labor Day weekend. Trey Dail explained that the runways will be open that weekend and wedge ramps will be installed so aircrafts can taxi off the runways.

- C. Richard Pearce will contact city offices and have a memo sent out to tenants notifying them of dates and times of construction.

RE: Airport to be closed for paving

Construction will begin on Thursday August 28<sup>th</sup> and will continue through Friday the 29<sup>th</sup>. The airport will be closed from 8:00 A.M. until 5:00 P.M. The airport will be open for the weekend, Saturday the 30<sup>th</sup>, Sunday the 31<sup>st</sup> and Monday September 1<sup>st</sup>. There will be no markings and there will be a 2 inch cut at each taxiway on the approach to the runway.

Work will resume on September 2<sup>nd</sup> and continue through the 4<sup>th</sup>. Again the closing times will be from 8:00 A.M. until 5:00 P.M.
