

**CHAPTER 2.86
MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGES**

- 2.86.010 Finding: The city has established a municipal department of the Grant County District Court pursuant to RCW Chapter 3.46. The city is required to provide by ordinance for the appointment of the judges of the District Court to serve as judges of the city's municipal department. (Ord. 1475, 1991)
- 2.86.020 Appointment of Municipal Court Judges: The Mayor shall appoint one or more of the currently elected or appointed district court judges and their pro tems as the part time municipal court judge or judges. (Ord. 1475, 1991)
- 2.86.030 Term and Removal: Any municipal court judge appointed by the Mayor shall serve in such capacity for his or her term as district court judge and may be removed from so serving in the same manner and for the same reasons as he or she may be removed from office of district court judge. (Ord. 1475, 1991)
- 2.86.040 Term Independent of Mayor: Any municipal court judge appointed by the mayor pursuant to this ordinance shall remain a municipal court judge for the duration of his or her district court term, despite any change in the status of the appointing mayor. (Ord. 1475, 1991)
