

Common Code Violations:

Graffiti: That is on fences, poles, houses or businesses.



Inoperable vehicles which are un-licensed, have flat tires, or cannot legally be operable on city streets.



Vehicles parked on the lawn or dirt and not on a designated driveway or improved parking surface such as concrete, asphalt, pavers or brick. Vehicles may also be parked on gravel in the side or rear yards but must be continuous from a designated driveway



Trees or plantlife that overhang any municipal improvement such as sidewalks or streets.



Weeds and grasses which are over 12" in height on the property must be cut. Also all noxious weeds need to be sprayed, cut and removed from the property

Garage sale signs:

Signs are not allowed to be placed on Power poles, Stop signs, Street signs, Streets, Sidewalks, Park land, Planter Strips or any City Right of Way. Signs must be removed at the end of the sale and the sale shall not last more than four consecutive days
