Wanted for: Toxic dumping

Dumping of materials into a storm drain is not only a bad idea: it's against the law.

This includes the following:

- Paint or solvents
- Soaps and detergents
- Chemicals (herbicides, pesticides, fungicides, fertilizer, household or cleaning chemicals, etc)
- Household wastes like cooking grease and oil
- Oil, grease, gasoline or other automotive fluids
- Solids and trash
- Concrete, dirt or gravel
- Sewage (including RV dumping)
- Yard waste (including grass clippings & leaves)
- Swimming pool or spa chemicals

Dispose of wastes properly – don't dump!
