



What are the responsibilities of Neighborhood Watch Members?

- 1) Learn neighbors names and be able to recognize them and their vehicles.
- 2) Keep a copy of the neighborhood telephone tree and neighborhood map in an easily accessible place
- 3) Attend meetings
- 4) Be alert to unusual or suspicious behavior in your neighborhood, utilize your phone tree and inform your Neighborhood Watch Captain. Call the police department EMERGENCY 911 – Non Emergency 509-762-1160
- 5) Do NOT take any risks to prevent a crime or try to make an arrest. Remember your job is to REPORT crime. Apprehending criminals is the responsibility of the professionals at the Police Department.
- 6) Display Neighborhood Watch window decals in prominent place at your home.
- 7) Watch your neighbors' homes when they are away. Ask them to return the favor. This includes picking up mail/newspapers and putting back garbage cans if left out. Do not leave signals that say " no one is home"
- 8) Be involved. It is the most effective way to reduce/prevent crime and make your neighborhood safe.
