

ORDINANCE NO. 2756

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 18.81 OF THE MOSES LAKE MUNICIPAL CODE ENTITLED "AMENDMENTS AND ZONING CHANGES"

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOSES LAKE, WASHINGTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 18.81 of the Moses Lake Municipal Code entitled "Amendments and Zone Changes" is amended as follows:

18.81.010 Amendments and Zoning Change Procedures: The regulations, classifications, or zone boundary lines may be amended by ordinance in the following manner:

- A. The Planning Commission, upon receipt of an amendment or zone change request, or after a motion of its own shall investigate the merits of the request. Staff shall set a public hearing date at which time the request can be considered.
- B. Following the hearing, the Planning Commission shall forward its recommendation and findings to the City Council.
- C. After receiving a recommendation from the Planning Commission, the City Council may consider the request. If the City Council finds the amendment is in the public interest, benefits the public welfare of the community, and is consistent with the city General Plan, it shall so amend this title.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and publication of its summary as provided by law.
