**Non-Commercial Lease from David Sonn:** Mr. Pearce has been working with an attorney, David Sonn, on the non-commercial leases. The Commission went through each item of the lease to make changes, word clarifications, and to remove and add information.


**Municipal Airport Policy:** The Commission was given a copy of the Moses Lake Municipal Airport policy in April 2022. President Grant received a letter from Mayor Myers on October 10, 2022, stating the Commission was out of compliance and had 30 days to get into compliance with the policy. City Councilman, David Eck, has been selected as a City Council liaison. Mr. Jackson asked the Commission to look at the policy and they went through and discussed each line item.

Councilman Eck handed out an airport budget report, prepared by the city finance director, Madeline Prentice.

Mr. Jackson stated, Representative Dent, called the state about the fuel system and found out there is a four-year grace period before payments need to be made.

The Commission also spoke about needing to elect new officers, ratifying the 2022 Airport operations manual and updating the city website for the airport.

Mr. Richeson made a motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded by Mr. Waltman and passed unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 4:39pm.
