OLD BUSINESS

A: CRACK SEAL OF TAXIWAYS: Current grant request is for engineering study only.  
TO is applying for 4 possible options,

1. Crack Seal
2. Crack seal an overlay
3. Repair and rebuild runway
4. rebuild with a wider runway, with new lights, etc.

All the state work is 2 years out, would happen in 2015, and does not include the  
taxiways.

There was discussion on using the sand and asphalt block that have been obtained  
to start making some repairs to the taxiway cracks. There will be some crack  
sealing done in the coming weeks to the taxiways. We could use some help from  
volunteers. Point of contact is Darel Fuller.

B:OPERATIONS & SECURITY MANUAL UPDATE: Judy has it and it is now ready to  
go.

C: WEED CONTROL : The Weed control is pretty good right now, but we will need  
to keep working on them to stay ahead. Lew made a motion to Pay Tom Dent  
\$462.50 for the chemicals that he had purchased to control the weeds. Jerry  
Richardson Seconded the motion. Motion passed 4-0.

D: MARTY SHAW FUEL SYSTEM: The system he has is a single wall tank. The price  
is about \$30,000. Concensus is that we don't want them.

## NEW BUSINESS

A: GRANT APPLICATION STATUS: David Ketcham is working on the grants.

B: COMMISSION APPOINTMENTS: Delon Krueger and Lew Mason were reappointed for two year terms.

C: CAMERA SYSTEM -OPERATIONS BLDG : The old cameras are not working very well. The basic unit is down, new equipment with same basic capacity of the old system will cost about \$1700 to replace. It is cheaper to replace it rather than repair it. WE will get 4 new cameras, same quality lenses, and a new VCR. Lew made a motion to replace the cameras and recorders, Jerry seconded the motion. The motion passed 5-0.

D: Other: Darel mentioned that the fairgrounds may have some surplus chairs of the same type that we currently have in the Operations Building. Free if we pick them up. He will look into getting some for us.

There was some discussion on a proposal by Paul Jones to build a hangar on the east side. No action was taken. There were several questions about the size of the proposal, and the required clearances from the taxiways. Those question will be Passed on to Mr. Jones.
