

Small Trees to Plant Under Power Lines in Moses Lake, as Recommended by the Community Assistance Forester, WA State Dept. of Natural Resources

Scientific name	Common name	Showy fall color	Showy flowers/season	Winter interest	Height/Spread	Drought tolerance	Notes
Acer campestre	Hedge Maple	bright yellow	no	yes	30-35' H 30-35' W	high	Slow growth; will make a dense, tall screen
Acer griseum	Paperbark Maple	red	no	yes: bark	15-25' H 15-25' W	moderate	Orange to bronze, peeling, papery bark
Halesia carolina	Carolina Silverbell	yellow	white/ spring	yes: bark	20-40' H 15-30' W	moderate	Bark peels in large, flat scales; prefers shade or partial shade
Malus species	Crabapple	no	pink, red, white/ spring	yes	10-25' H 10-25' W	moderate	Important to select a cultivar for disease resistance and small fruit. Flower color and mature tree size also depend on cultivar selected.
Sorbus aucuparia	European Mountain-Ash	red, yellow	white/ spring	yes	25-30' H 15-25' W	moderate	Fruit can be messy on pavement—not a good choice near sidewalk
